When resources arrived onscene, the fire had a 10% active perimeter, with winds out of the SW 3-5 gusts to 8 MPH. Fire had burned in grass and driftwood and appeared to be from an escaped campfire. Fire was called contained and controlled at 1335. Resources departed scene at 1431.
